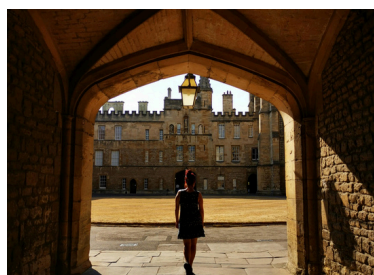
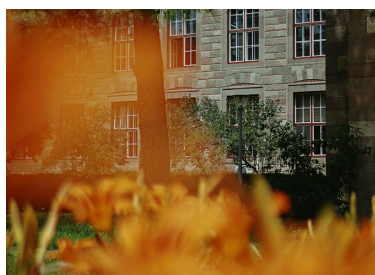
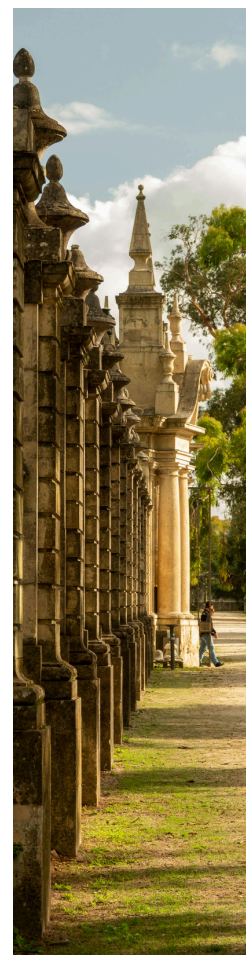

01. Course Selection

Once you've enquired and selected your chosen course and campus, you'll be asked to complete our online booking form. Upon receipt of your completed booking form, we will send you confirmation of your place, alongside an invoice for your booking and next steps

04. Preparation for course
